A NOTE FROM THE PASTOR



“Lord, teach us to pray.”
-Luke 12:1

One of the major activities we practice together at First Baptist Church is prayer. Every Wednesday night we gather for Bible study and prayer. Prayer is such big component of our life together that the Wednesday night gathering was called "Prayer Meeting" until just recently. To only slightly twist and old cliché we could say, "The church that doesn't pray together likely won't stay together." It's that important.

But how many of us really understand prayer? Or consistently practice a healthy prayer life? Or even know how to pray? Maybe you want to say along with Jesus' disciples in the verse from Luke cited above, "Lord, teach us to pray."

So, we are going to work on this together. Each Wednesday night I am going to include some brief instruction and thoughts on prayer. This will be incorporated into our service much like we currently do with mission awareness and education. Each Wednesday someone from the WMU takes three to five minutes to let us know about mission work going on somewhere around the world. We're going to do the same thing with prayer emphasis. Each Wednesday we will devote a brief time to instruction and encouragement regarding our prayer life. We will also begin to recite the Lord's Prayer in unison as a regular practice. Then we will get into our Bible study for the evening and share our prayer concerns, as we normally do.

The Wednesday format should look like this

Welcome & Opening Prayer

5 minutes for missions

5 minutes on prayer

Bible Study

Sharing praises and prayer concerns

Closing Prayer & Lord's Prayer

As Timothy Keller says in his book *Prayer*, "We must learn to pray. We have to."

BUSINESS MEETING for September 14, 2022
